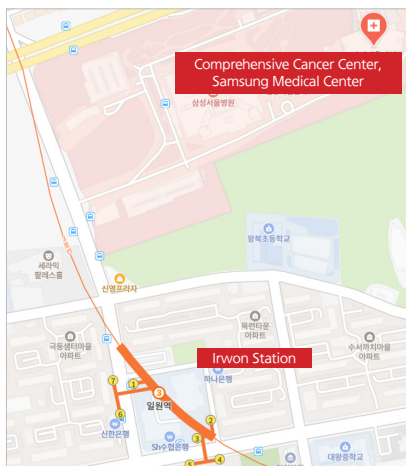
- Payment by credit card is possible only through the on-line registration system.

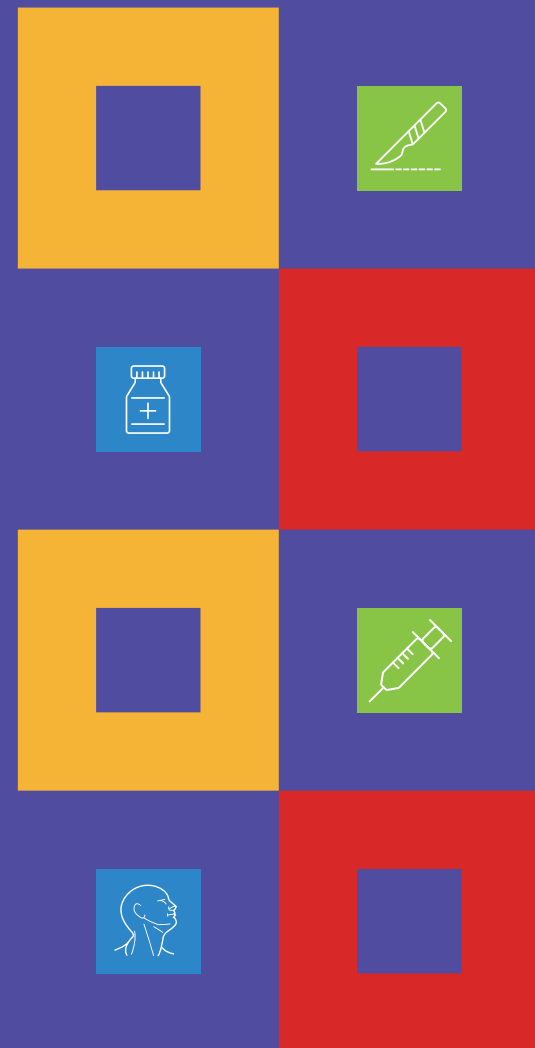
